Trinity Christian Academy Uniform Policy

The uniform policy has been in place since the inception of Trinity Christian Academy over 7 years ago. The uniform is designed to differentiate our students from regular public school students, but at the same time to provide a sense of commonness amongst the students that attend TCA.

Currently our uniform policy indicates the following:

- TCA Students must be wearing a TCA polo shirt and/or a TCA hooded sweater
- TCA Students must be wearing blue or black pants, shorts or skirt (jeans are not allowed). If students choose to wear shorts in warmer weather, we ask that the shorts have a length of slightly above the knee. Short shorts will not be allowed.

Some students have been attempting to negotiate around these two simple rules with a variety of choices that are purposefully made. As a result, we have been forced to add in the following clarifying rules in regards to our uniform policy.

- Only TCA hooded sweaters are to be worn over the TCA polo shirt. No other hooded sweaters will be allowed in class. Outerwear that the students may be wearing outside at recess time must be removed upon re-entering class.
- Denim jeans are not allowed, regardless of the color. This means no black, blue, or tan jeans.
- Leggings are allowed if they are a black or blue color and are worn with a skirt. Colorful patterned leggings will not be acceptable.
- Loose fitting yoga pants will be allowed. If pants are deemed too tight a note will be sent home asking the student not to wear these pants again.
- Shirts are allowed to be worn under polo shirts. Long sleeve shirts must be of a black, navy or white in color.
- Jewelry must be appropriate to wear at a Christian School. Spikes, studs or other attention grabbing jewelry will be removed and sent home with the student.

Casual Day / Spirit Days

One day a month we allow the students to come to school dressed out of uniform on our Casual Day. Usually, Casual Day is the first Friday of the month. We would like to clarify a few points in regards to Casual Day.

- Hats or toques are not allowed to be worn in the school on casual day
- Clothing should not have any inappropriate logos, sayings or designs. Any student deemed to be wearing something inappropriate will be asked to wear a sweater or to turn the clothing inside out.
- Female students should not be wearing short shorts, tight yoga pants or spaghetti strap tops
- Students may wear jeans.

Consequences for not adhering to the TCA Uniform Policy will be assigned based on the frequency of the discretion and the age of the student. Each case will be viewed independently and communicated with the parents or guardians.
